People do not have to have an entry in the flower show to come to the luncheon.

The event will take place at 12 p.m. on Wednesday, June 11, at Doolan's Shore Club, Highway 71 in Spring Lake Heights.

The price of the luncheon costs \$35, with the proceeds going to benefit the club's scholarship fund and other charitable endeavors. There will be a 50/50 raffle and the raffling off of gift baskets.

"We're looking forward to a wonderful day of fun and flowers," Mrs. Deicke said.

All entries for the flower show must be brought to Doolan's for judging between 8:30 - 10 a.m. the day of the event.

The categories for competition entries are: artistic arrangements [fresh flowers], artistic arrangements [dry or silk], yellow or white flowers in white containers [BWC members only], arrangements by themes [example: by the sea, imaginative creations], house plants, African violets and wall arrangements.

There will also be one award for best of overall show.
